

Two Events, One Goal: Charity!

CAYMAN – May 28, 2013 – The 4th Annual GAIM Ops Charity Night was held on April 21st in conjunction with GAIM Ops Cayman. Over 270 attendees enjoyed the cocktails and hors d'oeuvres served at the beautiful Luca Beachfront Restaurant. US \$38,647 was raised for charity of which Hedge Funds Care will receive one third! The two other charities were Michael's Mission and "R"Baby. Hedge Funds Care, a significant philanthropic presence in Cayman, focuses exclusively on preventing and treating child abuse. The almost \$13,000 received from the Annual Charity Night will be used by HFC Cayman to support programs on the islands that do the work of addressing child abuse in its many forms. The Charity Night itself was supported by five firms to whom HFC Cayman is extremely grateful: Global Funds Management, HF Fund Services, International Management Services Ltd. (IMS), Lowenstein Sandler and Walkers.

And, the 3rd annual HedgeServ and Harbour invitational Casino Charity Night was held at the Cracked Conch on April 23rd and raised US\$5,000 for HFC Cayman. In conjunction with the GAIM Ops Cayman hedge fund conference, the event included participation by more than 150 conference attendees, comprising a wide range of alternative investment managers, institutional investors, industry consultants, and service providers. A donation to HFC Cayman will be made in the name of the tournament winner – David Gold of Towers Watson. Finishing a close second was Neil Datta, from Optima Fund Management.
